Enclosed is your 2018 organizer. Certain lines in the packet contain information from last year's return. You do not need to change the dollar amounts from last year; these figures are provided for reference only.

Please review the entire packet and answer any questions that apply. When you are finished, you can either drop off your information at our office, email or mail it to us, fax it to us, or call our office if you feel you need an appointment. If you want to email us your information, call our office to arrange for a secure email. We also offer a pickup service for an additional fee. Please return to us your signed engagement letter, your organizer, all W-2s, 1099s, K-1s, real estate tax bills, mortgage interest statements and any other tax related documents.

Effective January 1, 2014, unless otherwise exempt, all U.S. citizens, their dependents, and other legal residents are required to have minimum essential health insurance coverage or pay a penalty. We have updated the questionnaire and documentation to help you provide us with the information we need to report your health insurance coverage status and complete the tax forms. Please provide us with all 1095 health insurance forms.

Clients who have their organizer and ALL their information to us by February 28, 2019 will qualify for the 34th annual Murphy Financial Services, Inc. drawing. The winner will receive a refund of the amount paid to have their 2018 tax return prepared.

In order to have your tax returns prepared by April 15, 2019 you will need to have all your information in our office by March 22, 2019. Clients bringing in their information after this date will be charged extra if they want their tax returns prepared by April 15, 2019. This is only if we have time to complete the returns by the due date. This does not pertain to K-1s. Call our office regarding K-1s.

An alternative to paying the extra charge is to get an extension. An extension allows you to file your taxes by October 15, 2019. This extension does NOT give you an extension to pay your taxes. Taxes are due April 15, 2019. Getting an extension does NOT signal the IRS to audit the return.
